Important Information

Berths in double cabins cannot be booked by passengers travelling alone. Children must be at least 7 years old and sleep in a separate berth. There are no child discounts.

The cabins are fitted with bunk beds (except on the main deck of M/S Diana and a few other exceptions) and they are about the same size as a small sleeping compartment on a train. All the cabins have a washbasin with hot and cold water. There are showers on all decks, except for shelter deck on M/S Diana, and toilets on all. As the berths vary in length, we ask that you tell us ahead of time if you are above average height (approx. 175 cm). The height of the ceiling on board is lower than standard.

The shelter deck contains the dining room and the lounge. On bridge deck there are comfortable chairs for relaxing and also a bar. The ship has a small onboard souvenir shop and a small ship's library. There is neither radio nor TV on board.

The tour guide holds daily information meetings in three languages (Swedish, English and German) to let you know what is going to happen during the day, tell you about the history of the canal and the local sites, as well as provide practical information. The tour guide is available throughout the cruise and even leads some of the shore trips.

Daytime wear should be comfortable, since much of the time is spent outdoors. Bring something warm, a windproof jacket and walking

shoes, in addition to your summer clothing. Tradition has it that the guests change to something a bit more elegant for dinner, but going so far as a dark suit is not essential – smart casual is quite sufficient.

Our ships are charming, but old, which means that thresholds are high and stairways steep. In addition, most shore excursions are on foot. For this reason, if you are physically disadvantaged, you should indicate this before departure date and bring along a personal companion.

The menu at lunch and dinner is fixed. Special requirements concerning food must therefore be notified in advance.

According to Swedish law, there are smoke-free environments indoors as well as outdoors on board the canal boats. Please ask the crew about the possibility of smoking in designated areas.

Arrival times are approximate, as weather and traffic conditions can cause some delays. For that reason you should arrange to have a good time margin for continued travel on the day of arrival. The shipping company cannot be held responsible for any additional costs in conjunction with delays that are beyond the company's control.

There is no long-term parking near the quays in Gothenburg and Stockholm.

Booking Conditions

Reservation and payment: A deposit amounting to 20 % of the price of the journey and any cancellation insurance are to be paid at the time of booking confirmation. Full payment of the remaining amount is due no later than 40 days prior to departure day. Should booking occur later than 40 days prior to departure, the entire amount shall be paid immediately. Special conditions apply to group reservations (10 persons or more).

Change fee: Changes in the booked trip leading to another departure date, point of departure, trip length or price will be seen as a cancellation and rebooking. In such cases a fee will be debited in accord with the cancellation rules below.

Cancellations: The following conditions are in effect for cancellations:

- On cancellation earlier than 40 days prior to departure date, any funds will be refunded, minus a cancellation fee of SEK 500 per person.
- On cancellation later than 40 days but earlier than 20 days prior to departure, the traveller must pay a cancellation fee equalling

50 % of the total price of the journey, as well as an administrative fee of SEK 500 per person. Remaining funds will be refunded.

- On cancellation later than 20 days prior to departure, or if the passenger(s) fail to appear at the time of departure, a cancellation fee equalling 100% of the total price of the journey must be paid. No funds will be refunded.
- Special conditions apply to group reservations.

Cancellation insurance: Passengers are advised to take out our cancellation insurance, which costs SEK 300 per person. It must be purchased at the same time as the journey and applies in the event of acute personal illness or acute illness, accident, or death involving a close family member/travel companion. The booking must be cancelled prior to departure in order for the cancellation insurance to apply. The cancellation must also contain a medical certificate issued by a licensed physician. Excluding the administrative fee of SEK 500 per person (which is always charged in the event of cancellation), the amount paid for the journey will be refunded. The cancellation insurance fee will not be refunded. Cancellation insurance can only be purchased by private individuals.

Changes prior to departure: The shipping company reserves the right to make changes to these terms and conditions for upcoming journeys. In the event of such changes, the provisions of the Swedish Act on Package Tours shall apply. The shipping company reserves the right to make changes to route, schedule, excursions, food, harbour stops etc. prior to the beginning of the journey.
